Aldebaran Robotics is a French SME created in July 2005 and based in Paris. The company, which currently consists of 80 members, designs, develops, and markets humanoid robots. With a computer and networking capability at its core, NAO, Aldebaran's first generation robot, is an evolving platform, which is currently unique in its ability to handle multiple applications. More than 350 robots have already been sold around the world, mainly to universities and research labs.

Selected by the International RoboCup committee as the successor of the Sony robot dog Aibo, NAO is proud to be the new official robot platform of the Standard League and the forerunner of many successors. Indeed, Aldebaran Robotics is currently preparing the introduction of a technophile-market version, and is already leading France's efforts to build a 1,4 meters tall humanoid prototype.
